- 1. Read Matthew 20:17-29 Jesus is predicting his death in Jerusalem for a third time. How does Jesus knowing that he is going to be put to death when he enters Jerusalem influence the importance of the way he chose to enter the city?
- 2. Read Matthew 21:1-5 What does quoting Zechariah 9:9 tell you about the King and the Kingdom of God vs. Caesar and the Roman Empire?
- 3. Read Matthew 20:20-28 The importance of serving others. How does this story reflect on the image that Jesus showed in his choosing to ride a donkey into Jerusalem?

TAKING IT HOME (Application)

- 1. How important is it for you to know that Jesus chose to take the journey to the cross for you?
- 2. If Jesus showed us how to be a servant how can we be a servant during our time of Sheltering in place?
- 3. I talked about not walking away from Jesus during this time of trauma and struggle. What can you do to show others you trust in God?
