GOING DEEPER/ Dixon First Reads Together

Hosea: *Background:* The dominant faith of Israel during Hosea's time was not Mosaic Judaism but a mixture of the worship of Yahweh and the local polytheistic baal religions. Israel was prosperous and complacent under Jeroboam II, but after his death, and a succession of six kings in 30 years, life became increasingly insecure and the nation's resources weakened. Israel stubbornly sought help from other nations instead of from the Lord.

Monday: Hosea 1, Hosea's Prophetic Progeny

Using the marriage metaphor, describe your relation to God, now and in the past.

Have you ever left or "cheated" on God? Was God faithful anyway?

Tuesday: Hosea 2, Israel Ruined and Restored

Since we become slaves of whatever we yield ourselves to (see Romans 6:16), what are the "baals"/masters in your life?

How is the Lord's authority different in your life than these other masters?

Wednesday: Hosea 3, Gomer Re-loved and Redeemed

Recall a broken relationship, (with spouse, kids, friends, boss, etc). Were you able to repair the relationship? How difficult was it?

When did God "buy" you back to Himself? How did God do it?

Thursday: Hosea 4, God's Case Against Israel

When has an injustice hit close to home for you? How did it affect you? Did you confront it?

What causes	moral or	spiritual	decline	in	individuals?	In society?
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What potential idol in your life might lure you away from God?

Friday: *Hosea 5, God's Wrath, Israel's Remorse* When you are hurt but a close friend what is your natural response?

When did you first learn of the benefits of discipline?

How do you picture the God of Hosea?
