

#### 1 Corinthians 10:26 The Earth is the Lord's and everything in it.

As you may know, the state insect of Illinois is the monarch butterfly. According to the International Union for the Conservation of Nature, the eastern population of monarchs decreased by 84% from 1996 to 2014. The monarchs are now classified as endangered-just two steps from extinction.

Some threats to monarchs included: habitat loss, pesticides, climate change, and illegal logging in the Mexican forests where the butterflies spend the winter.

Monarch butterflies and other pollinators are critical to the ecosystem. They fertilize plants that produce fruits and seeds. Here are some ways we can help:

- 1. restore natural areas
- 2. grow native plants that attract pollinators. Milkweed is important for monarchs, especially the larvae. Adults also like coneflowers and black-eyed susie. Since there are several types of milkweed, choose those native to our area. Some flower at different times. Research those native to Illinois and the best time and places to plant them.

Do <u>not</u> use tropical milkweed as it is invasive. Also avoid insecticide-treated plants. Free milkweed seeds are available at **saveourmonarchs.org** 

The monarch butterfly is the state insect of Illinois. Let's do our part to save these butterflies from extinction.

Remember: The world is in <u>our</u> hands. Go Green!

Can you believe it we are almost at the end of the summer looking forward to a new season coming soon with a great harvest of what we have planted in the spring? I feel like the summer began yesterday. But we are already moving toward the middle of August. Whenever I was looking back on the days and months of the year already passed by, I have always realized how much grateful I am for God's love and grace that God has poured over my life all through the moments that I have shared with the people that I love in Christ and all through the experience of God's loving presence among us.

This summer was especially flowing so fast for me with many valuable memories that could fill up the pages of my testimony of God's loving presence and guidance all through my life and call to the ministry. The first memory that allowed me to testify God's providence is the process of discerning our beyond the horizon vison that I was involved in with Pastor Tim and four members of our vision Team. While we were discussing the vision of our church as we call it "Beyond the Horizon Vision, I could witness the guidance of the Holy Spirit leading each of us to use our own spiritual gifts and contribute to the vision statement as the foundation of the ministries that we are planning for the next five years. As Paul proclaims in Roman 12:4-5, I could witness how we are, as the church, one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

<sup>4</sup> For as in one body we have many members and not all the members have the same function, <sup>5</sup> so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another. (Romans 12:4-5 NRSV)

The second memory filled with God's loving presence and grace is of the sharing of our lives during the Bible study on Colossians that we have been doing with the book, *The Domino Effect*, on Wednesdays this summer. As we were reading and listening to the text of Paul's letter to the Colossians and sharing with one another a catching word or verse, or a message that we could hear from the text connecting it to any experience of our Christian life, I could witness how the Holy Spirit would guide and connect us to each other as one family in Christ leading us into the way of Jesus Christ in his love and humility through the Word of God that we were reading and reflecting on together in the Bible Study with our hearts open wide to God and one another. For example, Paul's message about "Christ in y'all" in Colossians 2:2-3 reminded us of the importance of the church as a community of faith where we can find one another in Christ and "be encouraged in heart and united in love," as J. D. Walt says, to stay together enjoying the fellowship of the Holy Spirit.

<sup>2</sup> My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, <sup>3</sup> in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. (Colossians 2:2-3, NIV)

In addition to these memories related to the ministries and the loving community of the church, Dixon First, God allowed me to witness the wonder and beauty of God's creation in my first trip to Utah to see the majestic view of mountains and Great Salt Lake and feel humble and grateful to God's amazing grace over-flowing through the indescribable beauty of the nature. I was also experiencing God's loving care and peace

in my personal life when I was catching a summer cold with similar symptoms of COVID during my twin daughter and my son-in-law's visitation of my home for a week. Even in my illness, I was able to spend good time with them strengthened by the loving power of the Holy Spirit in feeding them with good food, visiting a beautiful state park near Dixon, and walking along the Rock River to see a flock of geese, pelicans, and ducks walking on the grass near the river, swimming on the river, or flying up and down through the river.
