By his great mercy he has given us a new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead ⁴ and into an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, ⁵ who are being protected by the power of God through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. ⁶ In this you rejoice, even if now for a little while you have had to suffer various trials, ⁷ so that the genuineness of your faith—being more precious than gold that, though perishable, is tested by fire—may be found to result in praise and glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. ⁸ Although you have not seen him, you love him, and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and rejoice with an indescribable and glorious joy, ⁹ for you are receiving the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls. ¹⁰ Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied of the grace intended for you made careful search and inquiry, ¹¹ inquiring about the time and circumstances that the Spirit of Christ within them indicated when it testified in advance to the sufferings intended for Christ and the subsequent glory. ¹² It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in regard to the things that have now been announced to you through those who brought you good news by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look!

That is the first room when you come out the powered door from the center of the Sanctuary into the hallway leading to the bathrooms and parlor. Instead of turning left, you go straight down the hallway like you are going to Pastor Young Sun's or my office. It is the first door on your right.

Leadership determined that we need to remodel the room to make it comfortable and inviting for our young children and families that would be using the nursery. It needs to be repainted. The room needs to have new carpeting and lighting. We are getting new toys. We have asked the parents that would be using the nursery what they wanted.

Our hope is to staff the nursery with volunteer servants. So, pray and see if God wants you to be a part of this essential ministry in our church.
