The Shepherd Speaks:

Greetings in the name of our Beautiful Lord and Savior Jesus Christ:

Welcome to 2024! A new year and, in many ways, a new beginning in our church. A couple of scriptures come to mind when I think of the new life offered to us in Jesus Christ. Isaiah 43:18-19 NIV, "Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past. See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland." The other passage comes from 2 Corinthians 5:17. "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" God is in the business of resurrection! God brings New Life and a new reality!

Another passage appropriate for Dixon First is Luke 5:37-38, "And no one pours new wine into old wineskins. Otherwise, the new wine will burst the skins; the wine will run out and the wineskins will be ruined. No, new wine must be poured into new wineskins."

Dixon First was slowly dying; it was old wine in old wineskins. But starting in 2020, during the pandemic, we became a new wine. We have become a Holy Spirit-led church. Take a moment to read the Holy Spirit moments from Becky Macklin and .Judy Gusse. Those stories tell the new life that is happening at Dixon First!

When I first came to Dixon in 2015, we had a church full of passionate people who wanted to make a difference in our community. But, we had no vision to channel that passion. Slowly, our passion began to wane. The pandemic allowed us to do a hard reset of our church. Through our Breakthrough Prayer, God transformed our congregation. Even though we were physically distant, we were connected deeply because we relied on our beloved Triune God. Once the pandemic ended, we were able to stay connected through the Holy Spirit and find God's Beyond the Horizon Vision for Dixon First.

Through our constant celebration of Holy Spirit Moments, we are now pouring our new wine into new wineskins, and God is doing something new! I hope that you are as excited as I am. GOD IS DOING SOMETHING NEW AT DIXON FIRST UMC! And you are a huge, HUGE part of that!!

We had our first Leadership Council meeting in January using the New One Board Model. Rev. Dr. Jaye Johnson, Director for Congregational Excellence, returned to lead us through the transition from the old to the new. This is another new wineskin for new wine! One of the most critical questions the Leadership Council must ask is, "Whose work are we doing?" The council is not the doer of the work of the church. They are the vision casters that enable the congregation to live into their commitment as disciples of Jesus Christ. The Leadership Council is charged with moving our Beyond the Horizon Vision forward. This is a significant shift in how the church is the church! It is a reminder of that wonderful children's song we sing! *I am the church. You are the church. We are the church together. All who follow Jesus, all around the world. Yes, we're the church together!*

We all have a part to play! God has gifted us and called us to Dixon First to be God's hands, feet, and voice to our community and beyond. What's your passion? What does God call you to do to fulfill our Beyond the Horizon Vision? As followers of Jesus Christ, we all have a vital role in sharing the love of God found in Jesus Christ!

During 2024, we will be helping and encouraging you to find and use your gifts for God's glory! Are you filled with some trepidation? Yes! Are you worried you don't have any gifts? Maybe! But remember Philippians 4:13, *"I can do all things through him (Jesus) who strengthen me!"* We are going to have an amazing story to tell in 2024!

Oh my goodness!! When I read about the opportunity to talk of the Holy Spirit and His working I was excited!!! Although I have seen His work many times I want to share one that many of you also witnessed. I am referring to 'Thank Offering Sunday' November 12th, 2023. This is traditionally a service lead by the United Women in Faith. Here is a glimpse of behind-the-scenes:)

Linda Frana has graciously put together this service in the last few years and 2023 was no exception. As the timing this year coincided with her nephew's wedding in Tennessee, she did the planning and responses prior. She then asked if I would do the announcing of songs, etc "and no problem", Pastor Young Sun would have the message that day. Unfortunately, procrastination is one of my failings. So...Tuesday evening of that week I decided to text Pastor Young Sun about getting together to make sure we were all on the same page. Wow! Was I ever surprised when she was unable to participate Sunday due to health concerns. Lynne was going to give the message.

The next evening I found myself sitting in my Jeep before choir practice and thought I have just GOT to call Lynne and tease her about getting herself into this situation and touch base regarding the service. Hmmm.....it didn't take long to see she was feeling overwhelmed as life was coming at her from all directions that week. She had already asked Jody to lead the service. As a friend I felt the need to ask her if there was anything with which I could help. OK, I said this with fingers, feet and toes crossed. Her response was if I could do the Pastoral Prayer...? Silently, I am literally shaking my head 'no' and repeating my question over the phone "what can I help you with"? Same response, Pastoral Prayer. O..K...!

0607 the next morning I found myself awake with the prayer being written in my head. I have been down this road before and KNOW the Holy Spirit wakes you in the night (no doubt because our day is 'loud') and when you think "I will remember the words", you don't.

Lynne, Jody and I decided we needed to meet so we could appear 'professional'. We laughed many times that if that phone call was not made, the three of us would have converged at the pulpit looking at each other wondering what the other was doing there. In that meeting Lynne told us she had changed her message title to 'Through it All' to which Jody responded "I think there is a song by that name". Should we change the closing hymn? The prayer was already written. (And) that is how the service, the message, the prayer and closing hymn became unbelievably cohesive. THAT is what happens each week as the pastors prayerfully put together the service and the songs are picked. THAT is the Holy Spirit!

And another Holy Spirit Moment from Judy Gusse...

A few months ago I was in the hospital awaiting surgery for a blocked artery and a brain aneurysm. The night before, after everyone left, I sat on my bed and began to pray. That's when God stepped into my story and became The Protagonist. There was a pressure on my arms that felt like arms around me and a very strong sense that Jesus was there and that I would be okay. The Holy Spirit that I had always felt or experienced in the spiritual realm entered my physical world in an unexpected way and brought me peace, love, and joy about my outcome from surgery.
